MADE by the Governor under section 62(1) of the Public and Environmental Health Ordinance for giving effect to any recommendations made by the of Public and Environmental Health Board.

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Public and Environmental Health (COVID-19)(Arriving Passengers Health Clearance)(Amendment) Regulations 2020 and shall come into operation on 22 July 2020.

Interpretation

2. In these Regulations “principal Regulations” means the Public and Environmental Health (COVID-19)(Arriving Passengers Health Clearance) Regulations 2020.

Regulation 4 amended

3. Regulation 4 of the principal Regulations is amended—

(a) in subregulation (1)—

(i) by deleting the word “seventy-two hours” and substituting the words “no later than twenty-four hours”;

(ii) by deleting paragraph (c) and substituting the following—

(c) upload proof of the person’s health insurance cover, as provided in regulation 6, and provide the insurer’s contact information;”;

(b) in subregulation (2) by inserting after the word “result” the words “and a copy of the health insurance certificate, if applicable”.

Regulation 6 amended

4. Regulation 6 of the principal Regulations is amended in paragraph (a) by inserting after the word “medical” the words “and quarantine”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Public and Environmental Health (COVID-19)(Arriving Passengers Health Clearance) Regulations 2020—

- (a) to require that a person intending to travel to the TCI to complete the travel authorisation form at least 24 hours prior to departure for the Islands;
- (b) to require that persons who are required to have health insurance to produce a copy of the insurance certificate to an immigration officer and health officer at the port of entry;
- (c) to require that the health insurance policy include coverage for quarantine costs.
